### Should You Add Salary to the Job Post?

**TIP:** 

List **non-financial benefits** like retirement plans, possible career advancements, or your vacation policy. Yes. You should share compensation on the job posting. This will help your job post show up in the correct searches and attract job seekers who are a genuine match for your opening. It's okay to put in a range for the hourly rate or salary.

Avoid using spammy phrases like "unlimited earning potential" or "Make CA\$H"as this could get your post flagged and taken down by job boards.
